It is very important that you study your fact families and know your addition and subtraction facts well, so that you will be ready for the next step in math.

Cursive writing is part of the third grade curriculum. You have learned to make the lower case letters of the alphabet and have begun joining these letters together to make words. Practicing will make your cursive writing stronger and better. Children who don't practice their writing on a regular basis tend to forget what they've learned and have a much harder time in third grade. Size and spacing do matter, so constant practice will make cursive writing both easier and fun!
