Update

As we navigate through the uncertainties that we are faced with as a result of the panic over the corona virus, please be assured that teachers are reminding their students to wash their hands, desks, light switches, doorknobs, and common areas are disinfected regularly, and Nurse Marks plans to do "hand-washing workshops" with each class in the coming days. As is the policy in general, if your child is sick, keep him or her home until he or she is fever free/vomit free for 24+ hours. Should a mandate come down requiring the closure of our school, work is underway to develop and refine plans for providing a virtual education, to the best of our ability, for our students.

I acknowledge that there are likely to be some difficulties along the way (i.e. access to technology; the utility of on-line learning for very young children, parent work schedules, etc.) but I am confident in the ability of our teachers to be flexible and accommodating to these difficulties in light of the many unknown that we face as we plan. We will all have to be open to taking one day at a time, learning as we go, making adjustments as necessary, and working together so that our endeavors can prove to be successful.

In the event that our school is closed for a period of time, you will get detailed instructions on how school-based virtual education plans will be implemented and rolled out and how your child will access the lessons.

I will continue to stay on top of the latest guidance from the Massachusetts Department of Health (MPH) and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). You will hear directly from me should a decision be made regarding closure for Our Lady of the Angels School.
