You will need the following supplies the first day of school:

- 3 ring binder (1/2" wide, no trapper keepers please)
- 3 pocket folders with holes (plastic folders are best)
- 1 package of filler paper
- 2 single subject notebooks
- Erasable blue or black pens
- Red pens
- Package of crayons
- Pencils
- Yellow highlighter
- Glue stick (one at all times)
- Plastic inch and centimeter ruler
- Child scissors
- Soft zipper pencil bag for supplies
- 1 package of baby wipes
- Tissues
- 1 Clorox disinfecting wipes (last name A-M)
- Paper towels (last name N-Z)
